Know all men by these presents that I John Bullion of the State of North Carolina Buncombe County for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred Dollars to me in hand paid before the delivering of these presents, Have Granted bargained and sold, and by these presents. Do Grant bargain sell & Release unto Alexander M. Kinny of Greenville District & State of South Carolina, a certain tract or parcel of land containing four hundred acres (the same more or less) situate and lying in Greenville District aforesaid on both sides of the head of North Pacolet. Including a certain tract of land of ninety eight acres. that the said M. Kinny is now in Possession of & made Purchase of from Jacob Frank lying and situate as aforesaid & bounded as follows, Viz, Beginning at a Stake and running N. 80. W. 80 chain to a black oak thence S. 10. W. 80. to a poplar thence S. 80. E. 80. to a black oak, thence N. 10. E. 80. to the Beginning corner, Vacant all corners when Surveyed, it being a tract of land originally granted to Michael M. Klerak the Fifth day of February A.D. 1787. Together with all and singular the Rights, Titles, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise appertaining therunto. To Have and To Hold all and singular the above Premises unto the said Alexander M. Kinny, his heirs and assigns forever. which I the said Bullion do warrant and forever defend unto the said M. Kinny against myself heirs and assigns, and every other Person, whomsoever lawfully claiming the same, or any Part thereof.
