

KNOW all men by these Presents that I Gibson Southern of the State of South Carolina & Greenville County this 18th day of November 1800 & two. Have for & in Consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Martin Dye of the State & County aforesaid, Have granted bargained & sold unto the said Martin Dye a certain tract or Parcel of lands, Containing one hundred acres be the same more or less - Lying the County aforesaid, & bounded as followeth, to wit, Beginning at a corner stake on Martin Dyes line - thence along a conditional line made by Gibson Southern & Martin Dye to a corner Chesnut on Martin Ayres line thence along the said Ayres's line to a corner pine thence along the said Ayres line to a corner Post oak on Robert M. Ayres line thence along M. Ayres line, to a black oak on Wriak Bonners line to a corner pine on Benjamin Bruces line thence along Bruces line to a corner Maple on Martin Dyes conditional line thence along the said conditional line to the Beginning which said tract of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned & sold unto the said Martin Dye his heirs and assigns forever, in fee simple and I do bind myself my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and forever defend unto the said Martin Dye his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & all & singular every other Person or Persons whatsoever from laying any lawfull Claim to the same or any Part thereof.
