W. 38. 50' to a hickory 3^x bounding on the aforesaid D. Gramum thence N. 30. W. 17. 50' to a Stake 3^x bounded on Benj^r. Arnolds land, thence running the different courses of William Gramums line to the Beginning, reserving 50 links on each side of Horse Creek through the said tract - Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining - To have and to hold all and singular the Premises above mentioned and Released unto the said William Gramum his heirs and assigns forever.
