bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said
Andrew Cooksey Jun^r his heirs or assigns a certain tract of land containing one hundred acres be the same
more or less, Situated in Greenville District aforesaid, on Reedy River, and runs as follows that is to say
Beginning on a post oak and runs straight to a turkey oak, and from thence to a black Jack and
from thence along the old original line to a red oak and from thence to a post oak & from thence to a
post oak, and from thence to George Tubb spring branch, thence up said branch as a conditional line
to a Persimmon & from thence a conditional line to a red oak on the head of a branch of reedy river
and down said branch to the old original line, & thence said line to the Beginning Together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belong-
ing or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the Premises before
mentioned unto the said Andrew Cooksey his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself
