State South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I William Goodgion of Greenville district for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me paid by John Townsend of the Dist. afores^d. Have granted & bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Townsend a tract or parcel of land in the Dist. afores^d. on the branches of the middle forks of Tygart river being part of two surveys one granted the 5th day of March 1794, the other on the 9th day of March 1791. unto Robert Goodgion containing by computation two hundred and thirty seven acres [Beginning at a post oak thence N. 21° 10' 30" chain to a post oak on the corner of land formerly Benjamin Headlions thence N. 55° W. 27 chⁿ 30 ft. to a white oak thence N. 28° W. 9 chⁿ to a black oak thence N. 50° W. 9 chⁿ to a chestnut thence S. 50° W. 22. chⁿ to a chestnut, thence S. 26 E. 69 chⁿ to a Stake on Clayborn Johnsons line thence along said line to a corner thence along his line till it meets a marked line, that is the line of one hundred acres that was conveyed to W^m Wood by Robert Goodgion which p^r line leads to the Beginning corner, Together with all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Townsend all rights numbers hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, To Have and To Hold the same, And I the said William Goodgion for myself my heirs Executors and administrators do hereby warrant & defend the afores^d premises unto the said John Townsend his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
