The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that William Scott of Greenville district and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of fifteen Dollars to me paid by Robert Scott of the State and district aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the s<sup>d</sup> Robert Scott all that plantation or tract of land containing seven & half acres by the same more or less Situate in Greenville District lying on the banks of Mountain Creek, waters of Saluda River, Beginning at a dogwood st. running thence N. 60. W. 16. chs to a white oak st, bounding on William Scott's land thence S. 10. W. 7 chains to a white oak st bounding on James McDavid land, thence S. 70. E. 15 chs to a rock st thence N. 10. E. 3 chs bounding on Joel C. Graces land to the Beginning, being part of a tract of six hundred and forty acres of land originally granted to David Humphreys on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1784. as s<sup>d</sup> Grant Recorded in Grant book. A. A. A. page 172. Together with all and singular the rights members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the s<sup>d</sup> premises belonging or in anywise Incident or appertaining - So Have & So Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Scott his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert Scott his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1807. and in the 31<sup>st</sup> year of the
