

part, Witnesseth that he the said Jonathan Blyth for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollar, to him in hand paid already by the said Joseph Harden hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell and make over & confirm unto the said Joseph Harden his heirs & assigns one certain tract or parcel of land, containing one hundred and a sixty acres, be the same more or less, being part of a Grants granted the fifth day annos Domini one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven, & in the Eleventh year of the united States of America and part of a Grants granted to Thomas Blyth, said land situated in the County of Greenville on the north side of Saluda, Beginning on a spruce pine on the said river at the mouth of the roaring branch, thence along a conditional line up the said branch made by Joseph Harden & Thomas Blyth to a ledge of rocks, to a corner white thence along the conditional line to another branch, above that to a corner spruce pine, thence, up the said branch to the fork to a corner, spruce pine, thence along the said dividing ridge in the fork of the branch to Thomas Blyth line thence along the said line to the corner, thence a straight course to Robert Bears da line thence along the said line to the creek, thence down the said creek to the river, thence down the various courses of the said river to the Beginning, and hath such shape and marks, as appears, by the plots annexed to said Grants represents certifies for Robert Bear, To Have & To Hold the said land & premises him his heirs & assigns against the said Jonathan Blyth his heirs & assigns, which the said Jonathan Blyth for himself his heirs and assigns forever, or any other person will warrant and forever defend, the title of the said land unto the said Joseph Harden his heirs and assigns, In Witness where of the said Jonathan Blyth hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & date first above written — Signum sealed & delivered in the presence of us, James Brock, John Swaffer, Joshua ^{his} _{mark} Roper, Abalom Blyth } Jonathan ^{his} _{mark} Blyth ^{his} _{mark} Seal
