


The State of South Carolina; Know all men by these presents that I Albert Robins  
of Greenville District and State aforesaid Planter, for and in consideration of the sum of Two  
Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Joshua Thompson of the County and State aforesaid  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted bargained sold released conveyed &  
confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain sell release convey & confirm unto the said  
Joshua Thompson & to his heirs & assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land lying & being  
in the District and State aforesaid, & on small branches of Saluda river & branches of Brushy  
Creek waters of Needy river, the same being originally granted to James Blasingame the  
second day of April 1784. & recorded in Secretarys office in grant book N. N. N. N. page  
486, reference being thereunto had may more fully appear, The part thereof hereby meant  
to be conveyed contains two hundred acres more or less. And runs as follows, Viz, Beginning  
on a stake near a small branch thence N. 86. W. 21. 50 to a post oak & thence N. 25. E.  
75: 30 to a stake & thence S. 70. E. 33. chains to a pine & thence S. 70. W. 26. 50 to a black  
oak & thence N. 83. W. 19. 50 to a stake & thence to the beginning. Containing two hun-  
-dred acres more or less. To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises above mentioned  
unto the said Joshua Thompson his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my-  
self my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises, against myself & my heirs, & against the just claim or claims of all &  
every other person or persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

Witness my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and five, and in the thirty ninth year of American Independance - Signed Sealed  
and delivered in presence of " W. Toney

the said Joshua Thompson a tract of land containing one hundred and twenty eight acres  
situate in Greenville District aforesaid on the fourth branch of Brushy Creek a branch  
of Needy river and hath such form shape marks and bountings as a plat hereunto annexed represents
