Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I Elizabeth Hudson of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and fifty six dollars to me in hand paid by William Hudson of the district and State aforesaid Have granted bargained sold & Released by by these presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said W^m Hudson all that parcel or tract of land lying in S^d District containing one hundred and twenty eight acres of land, it being a part of the real estate of Forest Hudson deceased, bounded as follows, Beginning at a conditional corner on the branch thence N. 85. W. 33. 50 to a black oak corner thence S. 5. W. 44. to a black oak corner thence N. 55. E. 10. to a history corner thence S. 45. E. 26. 25. to a conditional corner on the branch thence with the meander of the branch to the Beginning corner, containing one hundred and twenty eight acres of land, Together with all and singular the rights members & Hereditaments & appertaining to the S^d premises belonging or in any way incident or appertaining. To Have and to Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Hudson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs & adm^{rs} to warrant and forever defend all and singular the S^d premises unto the said W^m Hudson his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Pursuant to the directions of David Goodlett Alexander Waddle George Ruple Elisha Green Esq. and George Underwood Commissioners appointed by the Honorable court of Greenville to divide the real estate of Forest Hudson dec^d I have laid out the above tract of one hundred & twenty eight acres of land for Elizabeth Hudson one of the children of the S^d dec^d it being the lot drawn by her after the division bounded northwardly & westwardly by vacant land at the time of the original survey being made southwardly by David Goodlett's land & eastwardly by a branch of the river & lot No. 2 that such shape & marks as the above plot represents agreeable to the original Plat - Certified for the 6th day of December 1805 - Geo. Salmon Deputy Surveyor.
