To Have and To Hold all and singular the above named premises unto the said
Joseph Terry Sen^r his heirs and assigns - and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend the same from every person or persons
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, In Witness whereof
