Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars, to me in hand paid by Rice Beusow of the aforesaid district and State aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Rice Beusow one certain tract or Parcel of land, containing fifty one acres be the same more or less situate in Greenville District on both sides of Enoree river bounded as follows viz. Beginning on a Stake, thence S. 45° W. 14° 50' to Pine, thence N. 54° W. 5° 00' to the mouth of a branch thence crossing Enoree and up the same as it meanders S. 71° W. 3' to a maple, thence N. 20° W. 13° 50' with the meander of the same to a white oak thence N. 58° E. 19° 40' to a white oak near the head of a spring, thence S. 81° E. 15' to a small hickory thence S. 20° E. 8' to a black oak in the fork of S^d. Enoree thence up the south fork and crossing the same to the Beginning - it being a part of two tracts the one originally granted to John Tubb by his excellency W^m Moultrie Esq^r and the other the tract wherein I now live. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the s^d premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Rice Beusow his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Rice Beusow his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs or any other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this sixth day of April one thousand eight
