 Containing Two hundred acres of lands, more or less, Together with all and singular  
 the rights, members, Hereditaments & appurtenances to the 3<sup>d</sup> premises belonging  
 or in any wise Incident or appertaining - To Have and To Hold all and singular the  
 premises before mentioned unto the s<sup>d</sup> Horatio Griffin his heirs and assigns forever,  
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant &  
 forever defend all unto the s<sup>d</sup> H. Griffin his heirs and assigns, against my self, my  
 heirs and assigns all and every other Person, or Persons whatsoever - In Witness whereof  
 I do hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth 20<sup>th</sup> of March 1808. - - -

 the year Eighteen hundred and Eight, between Jeremiah Strother of the first part  
 and Charles Bonson A.D. Bradley & Esby Hunt of the second part: Witnesses the  
 that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of  
 four hundred Dollars of good and lawfull money of the united States to him  
 in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof  
 is hereby confessed and acknowledged, Hath granted bargained sold con-  
 firmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release & confirm  
 unto the said party of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns one Negro man  
 Nepton which I purchased from Sion Sanders, and my Negro girl Francis she being about  
 thirteen or fourteen years of age, To Have and To Hold the said Negroes hereby rel-  
 eased and confirmed, unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and  
 assigns forever, provided always and these presents are upon this express con-  
 dition that if the said Jeremiah Strother his heirs executors and administrators do and
