Beginning at a post oak standing thence N. 10. E. 42 Chain to a post oak thence 82. E. 13 chain to a red oak, thence N. 12. E. 23 Chain 25 lks to a lightwood, near y on Rob Goodgion corner on the N. side of the Charleston Road thence S. 88 E. with Goodgion line 29. Ch. 50 lks to a red oak thence N. 60. E. 25 Chain 50 links to a red oak near Molloy's creek thence N. 66. E. 13 Ch. 40 lks (across the creek) to a red oak thence S. 68. E. 11 Chs. 50 lks to a black oak on the ancient Indian Boundary line, thence S. with said line crossing the creek 127 Ch. 6 to a post oak (Carrons corner) (crossing the Charleston road) thence S. 56.
