This Indenture made this twenty first day of January one thousand Eight hundred and eight between George Shelton of the one part and William Shelton of the other part both of the State of South Carolina Greenville district containing that the said George Shelton for the consideration sum of fifty Dollars to him or hand paid by the said William Shelton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I the said George Shelton have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell a tract or parcel of Land lying on the waters of Saluda river containing one hundred acres more or less being part of a tract granted to John Stanford
