sum of fifty Dollars paid by Robert Carter of the district aforesaid, I have  
granted bargained sold and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and release unto the said Robert Carter all that tract or parcel of land  
supposed to contain twenty three acres be the same more or less, being a part  
of a tract granted to Samuel Hags and by him conveyed to William  
Stewart Sr, which said twenty three acres lying on the north side of Clear  
Creek of the South Fork of Sugar River, Beginning on a black oak near the  
road, which is Carter Langley, & Robert Carter Corner running thence the  
course of Langley line to a sweet gum in an old field thence up the bank  
a conditional line to a black gum on the bank of the creek, thence down  
the various courses of the creek to Jeremiah Hruces line, thence along said line  
to Robert Carters line, thence along Robert Carters line to the Beginning, Together  
with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments, & appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining  
To have and To Hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto the  
said Robert Carter his heirs and assigns, forever, and I do hereby bind myself my  
heirs, Exec<sup>rs</sup> & adm<sup>rs</sup> to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
Premises unto the said Robert Carter his heirs and assigns, against myself and  
my heirs, & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand & seal this 24<sup>th</sup> day of September  
1808 and thousand Eight hundred and five, in the 30<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence
