Mury Dupree of Oglethorpe county and State of Georgia for & in Consideration  
of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry S. Walker of Green  
District & State aforesaid, I have granted bargained & sold & by these presents  
do grant bargain sell & release, unto the said Henry S. Walker all the  
tract Parcel or plantation of land supposed to contain Two hundred acres  
the same more or less, it being a part of a tract of 500 acres originally given  
to Isaac Perkins by Patent bearing date the fourth day of April 1796  
and Recorded in G. book C. N. 5. page 390. Situate in Greenville District  
State aforesaid on both sides of Gray's branch water of Quiller of Enoree River  
Including the plantation whereon S. Dupree did live Beginning on stake corner  
on the original line & dividing corner between S. Dupree & Edward Pierce & D.  
on the original line north fifty chains to a Stake corner old for said tract the  
N. 20. W. 14. 50. to Post oak corner, then N. 60 E. 54. 50. to a Post oak corner on John  
Butlers line then S. 69, chain to a Stake corner thence a direct line to the  
Beginning Stake corner, which include the full land to be conveyed be the same  
more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members & Hereditaments  
and appurtenances unto the said premises belonging or in any wise Inced  
or appertaining, unto the said H. S. Walker His Executors administrators or assigns  
and I the S. Dupree do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators  
to warrant and forever defend the above described premises unto the said  
H. S. Walker His heirs and assigns forever, against myself my heirs Executors  
administrators and assigns, and against every other person or persons whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand  
and seal this twentieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand  
Eight hundred and four, and in the twenty eight year of the Independance  
the united States of America -
