




 Greenville in the state aforesaid, do send Greeting. Whereas I the said John Archer
 by my bond or obligation bearing even date with these presents stand indebted to
 William Walton and John Walton otherwise called William Walton & Company of the
 City of Charleston in the state aforesaid, Merchants, in the final sum of Four thousand Eight
 Hundred and forty six dollars seventy cents with a condition thereupon written for the
 payment of the sum of Two thousand four hundred and twenty three dollars 33
 cents, with lawfull interest from the date, unto the said William Walton & Company
 their or either of their heirs Executors administrators or assigns with Legal Interest thereon
 as in and by the said bond and obligation, and condition thereupon written (relation
 thereunder being had) doth more fully and at large appear, Now Know Be that I
 the said John Archer for the better securing the payment of the said sum of Two
 Thousand four hundred and twenty three dollars & thirty five cents unto the said William
 Walton & Company their heirs Executors administrators or assigns, together with Lawfull
 Interest for the same, Have bargained and sold, and by these Presents do bargain & sell
