Know all men by these Presents that I Joseph Davis of Greenville District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander Robbs of the State & district aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander Robbs all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty five acres being part of a tract of five hundred acres originally granted to Job Coltrone (and conveyed by them to s^d Davis) bounded on the east and south by Robert Connells land N. W. by Edward Smiths north east and north by Joseph Smiths land lying in said District and hath such a form and mark as the above plat represents, Together with all and singular the rights and hereditaments and appurtenances to the said ~~one hundred and twenty five~~ acres belonging or in any wise appertaining. To Have and To Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alex^r Robbs his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs Ex^{ors} & admin^{rs} to warrant & forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alexander Robbs his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof —
