This Indenture made the Eighth day of November in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between Elisha Simmons of the State of
South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part, and William Taylor
of the afor^d County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Elisha Simmons
for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds Sterling money to him
in hand paid by the said William Taylor the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, He the said Elisha Simmons hath bargained and sold and by
this presents doth bargain and sell unto the said William Taylor a certain tract
or piece of land lying and being in Greenville County containing one hundred
acres it being part of a tract of a tract originally granted to Elisha Simmons bearing
date first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and ninety four, Beginning on a small red oak and running S 60. West 38 to a
post oak thence N 47. W 9 to a post oak thence N 12. W. to a Stake where it is to make
quantity sufficient to make one hundred acres thence N 60. E. 58 to a Stake on the
old line thence S. S. E. to the Beginning. which said tract of land of one hundred acres
with all and every of its appurtenances the said Elisha Simmons doth from himself
and his heirs and from all and every other persons or persons will, warrant &
and forever defend, to the said William Taylor his heirs and assigns
