McMichen their Executor adm<sup>r</sup> or assigns the just & full sum of Seventy four Dollars in two years after the date above mentioned then these presents and every article therein Contained, shall cease determine and be void or Else remain in full force and Virtue, and further for the maintenance of every article herein contained I do by these presents bind myself my heirs Executors adm<sup>r</sup> or assigns forever to warrant and defend the right of the said property. One feather bed \$30.00. House hold and kitchen furniture \$150. 1200 lb<sup>s</sup> of Flour \$36. 16 head of hogs \$40. 6 head of Cows \$40. 80 barrels of Corn \$200. 3000 lb<sup>s</sup> of Cotton \$360. 1 waggon & gear \$150. 6000 feet of plank \$60. I bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and defend the said property forever from every Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the said property. Received nine hundred and fifty seven dollars & 50 cents in full. Sealed with my seal and dated the twenty four<sup>th</sup> of October 1808. Jst Saml McCrary
