

This Indenture made this twenty day of November one thousand Seven hundred and ninety nine, between John Moody of the one part and Howell Hilde of the other part, Witnesseth that the s^d John Moody for the sum of one hundred pounds to him in hand the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, & the said John Moody hath bargained sold, and by these presents doth grant Bargain & Release unto s^d Howell Hilde his heirs and assigns one certain tract of land containing two hundred and forty one acres more or less, Situate lying and being in the county of Greenville including the head of the Reedy fork of Reedy River, being a tract of land granted to Jesse Moody by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney in the year one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight bounded by lines running S. 40. W. by James Seaborns land S. 40. W. by Jacob Blacks land N. 60. E. by land unknown the other side, by vacant Land, having such shapes and marks as the plat thereof directs to the original grant annexed, Together with all and singular the said tract of two hundred and forty one acres more or less unto the said Howell Hilde his heirs and assigns forever, To Have and To hold the s^d piece of land afores^d with all the premises and everything thereunto belonging, and the s^d John Moody for myself my heirs and assigns doth covenant and agree to & with the said Howell Hilde his heirs and assigns shall and may at all times hereafter hold and possess the afores^d land, without the least molestation of him the said John Moody his heirs and assigns to him the said Howell Hilde his heirs and assigns, I do warrant and forever defend the afores^d land from & against all claim or claims that now is or hereafter may be made by any person or persons whatsoever respecting or in the smallest degree effecting the said piece of land afores^d unto the said Howell Hilde, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affix my seal the day & year above written - Signed Sealed and Delivered in presence of us, Reuben Moody } John Moody Esq^r
