State S. Carolina Greenville District. Know all men by these presents that  
 I Benjamin Townsend of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of  
 Four hundred and twenty <sup>seven</sup> Dollars to me paid by William McCallah of the  
 State and district aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released and  
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said McCallah  
 a plantation and part of three original tracts of land one granted to Jesse  
 Chandler for 640 acres on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of January 1785. Recorded in grant book  
 C.6.66 the other two not known then conveyed round to s<sup>r</sup> Townsend now from s<sup>r</sup> Townsend  
 part of three tracts to s<sup>r</sup> McCallah, Beginning on a ~~land~~ creek on a Chickapin running  
 thence to a white oak thence S. 70<sup>ch</sup> 10. 24. 13<sup>th</sup> to a red oak thence S. 34. 6 chain  
 to a dogwood thence S. 56. 6. 8 chain to a stake thence S. 5. 10. 22. 14<sup>th</sup> to a stake then  
 S. 85. E. 20 ch. to a hickory S. 23. 10. 27. 70<sup>th</sup> to a post oak then S. 67. E. 17. to a persimmon then  
 N. 35. E. 56. 80 to horse creek then with said creek its several courses to the Beginning  
 Including the plantation where Benj<sup>n</sup> Townsend now lives. Together with two  
 hundred and eighty five acres of land situate in the district aforesaid on the waters  
 of horse creek a branch of Peey River, Together with all and singular the Rights  
 Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 Incident or appertaining, To have & To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
 unto the said William McCallah his heirs and assigns forever, & I do hereby bind my-  
 self and my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
 the premises above mentioned unto the said Wm. McCallah his heirs and assigns against  
 myself & my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to  
 claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this Eighteenth day  
 of July Eighteen hundred and six, and in the thirtieth year of the independence of the
