NOW Know ye that I John Sammon administrator as aforesaid as well by virtue of the power and authority to me given as aforesaid as in consideration of the sum of Thirty two Dollars to me paid by Shadrach Trammel of said District the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, Have granted bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Shadrach Trammel his heirs and assigns forever the said described tract or parcel of land situate as aforesaid. Together with all and singular the Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and To hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Shadrach Trammel his heirs and assigns forever, and I do in the Capacity aforesaid covenant to and with the said Shadrach Trammel his heirs and assigns that the premises aforesaid shall be free from all incumbrances and that I will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said Shadrach Trammel his heirs and assigns forever against myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the third day of March one thousand Eight hundred and six. Provided always that one Quarter of an acre is hereby Excepted around the grave of the above named William Sammon Sr. Signed Sealed and Delivered

Witnesseth that for and in consideration of two hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Aquila Wilson the Receipt whereof the said William Tubb doth hereby acknowledge, Hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Aquila Wilson a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and ninety acres more or less lying and being in the District of Greenville State of South Carolina on the head
