I do Have & So Hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Aquilla Wilson his heirs and assigns forever, and I do for myself my heirs Executors & Administrators warrant & forever defend the said premises to the said Aquilla Wilson his heirs Executors administrators or assigns against myself my heirs, and against all manner of Persons claiming the same lawfully. Know all men by these presents that I Shadrach Grammel of State and District afores<sup>d</sup> for the consideration of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Aquilla Wilson, Have bargained sold and conveyed, & by these presents do bargain & convey unto said Wilson a tract or parcel of land containing Sixty acres be the same more or less situate in the District aforesaid, on both sides of a branch of Enoree River and runs as follows. Beginning on a red oak in said Norris's line thence across the waygon Road to a post oak thence to the head of a branch near to the place where Norris settles thence down said branch to the mouth thereof, thence up the other branch to the said Road thence with said road to hickory near where Moore's old path crosses said Road thence with said path to Prince's Stake corner, on or near Norris's line thence with said line to his corner, near the Spring thence to the beginning. Which includes the full lands to be conveyed, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident to the same unto the said Aquilla Wilson him & his heirs forever and I do by these presents forever warrant said land & thence unto to be good to s<sup>d</sup> Wilson his heirs &c against the claim or claims
