W. 46. with the original line to stake then N. 50. E. 34. 50 across the River cornering to Post then S. 38. E. 46. Ch. 50 cornering to two pines 31 m then S. 30. W. 40 Chains across the said River, on the old line of s^d tract. Including two hundred acres the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Pollard his heirs and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benj^t Pollard his heirs and assigns, against our self our heirs, and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. This Indenture made this twenty eight day of November and in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and eight between William Griffith of the District of Greenville of the one part, and David Mafey of the same District of the other part. Witnesseth that the said David Mafey for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Eight Dollars 62^{cts} to him in hand paid, have mortgaged unto the said William Griffith his heirs or assigns the following Property (Viz) one bay mare two cows & yearling & seven heads of hogs one large pot & spider also two feather beds and furniture also Eighteen hundred weight of cotton and Corn fodder &c also one small pot one table one chest also seven and furniture, Which said property the said Mafey mortgages unto the said Griffith in virtue of having had and received of the said Griffith the said sum of Eighty Eight Dollars 62^{cts} the said Mafey having the Equity of Redemption that is to say paying and discharging the said sum of Eighty Eight Dollars 62^{cts} on or before the first day of March 1810. with lawfull interest from the date of this presents then
