 forty four acres granted to Joseph Whitmer under the hand of his excellency Tho:
 mae Pinckney then Governor of the said State of South Carolina, and the great seal
 of the said State, and duly recorded in the Surveyors office, reference being thereto,
 had with more fully appear, which said one hundred and forty four acres of
 land was conveyed unto said John Thomas Junr. by the said Joseph Whitmer by an
 Indenture bearing date the eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight, and duly recorded in the Clerk,
 office of the said County of Greenville reference being thereto had with also appear
 and is now granted and conveyed by the said John Thomas unto the s: Edward
 Watson. Together with all and singular the premises, to the said Thirty
 acres more or less belonging: To have and to hold, the said bargains &
 sold thirty acres, of land with all and singular the premises & appurtenances thereto
 belonging, or in any wise appertaining, with all the wood and wood, timber &
 timber trees, Houses outhouses, field, and water & water courses, liberties, & profits
 what so ever therunto belonging, and the reversion and reversions remainder & remainders
 rents issues and seises thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof unto the said Edward
 Watson his heirs executors adutors & assigns forever. And the said John Thomas Jr.
 his heirs executors & administrators doth covenant and agree to and with the s: Edward
 Watson that he and his heirs & sons & assigns shall from time to time, at all
