

State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that James McKee of York District in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Allen Marshall of Greenville District and State aforesaid.

Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Allen Marshall all that tract of land surveyed for Arthur Stafford thence according to Sam^l McKee then willed by him to James McKee containing five hundred acres lying in the District and State aforesaid lying west of the Old Indian Boundary on the branches of the Beaverdam Creek and of Tyger River, about one mile above the old line, bounding South on land laid out to John Cornents all other sides of vacant land, and hath such shape and marks as are herein Represented, Viz; Beginning at a hickory running South 71 Chains to a red oak, thence N 80 W 71 Chains to a red oak, thence N 71 Chains to a post oak and thence South 80 E 71 Chains to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the sd Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and To Hold and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Allen Marshall his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Allen Marshall his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs, and against every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Barton of Greenville District for and in consideration of the love good & Paternal affection I have and do bear to my son David Barton of the District aforesaid hath given and granted and by these presents do freely give and grant unto the said David Barton a tract or plantation of land lying and being in the District aforesaid on both sides of the N fork of the Tyger River, Beginning at a Pine Corner near Massey Axsmiths ditch, and Robert Goodlets corner, running thence N 40 E 37 Chain to a Black oak sappling thence S 44 E 54 Ch 57 lks to an ash thence S 40 W 37 Chain to a stake Robert Goodlets corner thence N 44 W 54 Ch 57 lks to the Beginning.
