Moore & Betsy M. Moore, the children of Robert B. Moore one negro woman named Esther and by these presents do warrant and defend the right of the said negro woman to the aforesaid children and their heirs free from the claim of me or my heirs and from the lawful claim or demand of any other person or persons whatever, and for the better performance of the same I have put the before mentioned children in full and peaceable possession of the said negro woman
