Containing one hundred and forty two acres bounded on all sides by vacant Land surveyed by George Salmon Together with all and singular the rights members here detasments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. So have I do hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elijah Joy his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Elijah Joy his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord 1808. Together with all and singular the
