 James Pitt of the District of Pendleton in the state aforesaid in considera-  
 tion of the sum of one hundred Dollars to in hand paid by Catharine Richardson  
 of Greenville District and state aforesaid have granted Bargain'd sold  
 and released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release  
 unto the said Catharine Richardson all that tract plantation or  
 parcel of Land situate lying and being in the District of Greenville on  
 Branches of Saluda River Beginning on a pine thence 139 1/3 chains to  
 a stake thence South 46 chains and 75 links to a stake and Red oak  
 thence 137 81 chains to a post Oak thence 170 1/30 chains to the Beginning  
 pine containing one hundred acres be the same more or less together with  
 all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances  
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
 thereto and to hold back and singular the said premises before  
 mentioned unto the said Catharine Richardson her Heirs and assigns  
 forever and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs &c and against the  
 Executors and Administrators to Warrant and forever defend against myself my Heirs &c and against the  
 Lawful Claim of all Persons whomsoever. This Testimony whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
 hundred and nine 1809<sup>th</sup> year of American Independence
