 dollars to me in hand paid by Jesse Griffin of the State and district. Have granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said one certain tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred acres more or less
 situated in Greenville District on the waters of Beavordam and bounded as follows (viz)
 Beginning on a Maple on Elliott Clardys line thence Northly to Thomas Springfields corner
 on a red oak thence Westwardly on said line to a conditional line run by Abalon Hooks
 and Jesse Griffin thence along said line to the Grassy branch thence up Sth Branch to a
 line run by George Salmon thence S. 60. to a lightwood Stake thence South 81.6. to a chestnut
 thence to the head of Daniel Spring branch thence down the branch to the
 Beginning. Together with all & singular the rights members Hereditaments Appurtenances
 to said land and premises or in any wise incident or appertaining. So Have & So Hold all singular
 the land and premises before mentioned unto the said Jesse Griffin his heirs and assigns, and
 I do hereby bind myself and my heirs to warrant and for ever defend the said land and premises
 unto the said Jesse Griffin ~~his~~ ^{Witness} my hand and seal October the 7th day 1808.
