W. 14 ch. 60. to a black gum thence S. 68. E. 30 ch. to a white oak on a branch thence up the meanders of said branch to a black gum station in the original line, thence N. 68. W. to the Beginning. Containing as before described forty four acres which land & premises before described I bind myself my heirs &c to warrant and defend all the premises before mentioned unto the said Tho: Edwards in trust for the said McFlanahan and Children from me & my heirs and from every other Person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Given under my hand & seal this 2nd day of November 1809. in Presence of
