Sarah and her three children one negro girl named Winney & that it may  
be clearly understood my daughter Sarah is to have hold & possess the s<sup>d</sup>  
negro girl Winney during her natural life & at her death then the negro  
Winney together with her increase to be Equally divided between the  
three children above named viz, John, James, & Preshy Ford In Witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 26<sup>th</sup> day of January  
1810. signed sealed & delivered in presence of us  
And W. O. Walker William Cornelius James Walker

within mentioned James Walker sign seal acknowledge and deliver
