State of South Carolina, Greenville District; January the fifth one thousand eight hundred and ten, Know all men by these presents that I Stephen Morgan of the State of South Carolina & Greenville district am held and firmly bound unto Eli Langford of the State and District above mentioned for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred and forty Dollars paid me in hand, I therefore have granted bargain & sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Eli Langford a part of a tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the State of South Carolina in Greenville District binding on the south side of the middle fork of fall creek of Saluda River butting & bounding on the rich mountain Beginning at said fall creek running South W. to a stake from thence South E. near to a stake joining Cairns line, then running on the steep part of the mountain between Morgans fields and Cairns from thence to Fords line from thence to the Beginning corner containing two hundred acres be the same more or less it being granted to John Elledge by patent bearing date the second day of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety three, Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Eli Langford his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the s^d premises from any person or persons having any Lawful claim or writ to the above mentioned premises, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal this day & date above mentioned.
