 whatsoever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and adminis-
 trators to warrant and forever defend the said Negro unto the said Geo W
 Earle his heirs and assigns Witness my hand and seal this eighth day
 of February 1810.

 plantation or tract of Land lying & being in the district and State aforesaid on the
 head of the Reedy fork it being part of a tract originally granted to Jeph Moody by his
 Excellency Thomas Pinckney in the year 1788. the Land to be conveyed Beginning on the
 trail road on a P. oak 37 running N. 20 E. 7: 90 to a black Jack, N. 65 E. 33: 14 to a P.
 oak, thence S. 45 E. 23: 50 to a post oak thence S. 20 W. on Jacobs black line to a maple
 stump, thence on a conditional line supposed near the s^d - comes to Seabornes
 line: thence on said line to a stake on the Road thence on said Road a condi-
 tional to the Beginning. Including one hundred and forty one acres more or less
 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances
 to the s^d premises belonging or in any wise appertaining or Incident to. Do Have
 and do Hold all and singular to the s^d Saml Hicks & I the s^d Noel Hild do
 hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant and forever defend all and
 singular the premises before mentioned to the said Saml Hicks his heirs & assigns
