Harbin of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of five
Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Blagrove Glim of the State and district
aforesaid I have granted bargained sold and released unto the said Blagrove Glim
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or plantation of Land containing two
Hundred acres including the plantation whereon said Blagrove Glim now lives
including the first mill built by said Glim together with the mill stones Irons & all
the appurtenances unto the said mill belonging & situate in the State & district aforesaid
Beginning on a gum & on the North side of Rocky creek & runs S. 78. 20 to a stake 34
then S. 23. W. 20 to Post oak & then S. 57. N. 2 to a pine 34 then S. 35. E. 35 to a red oak 34
then S. 30. E. 5 to Peach 34 on the bank of Long branch of said creek then down the
boundary
