 Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of three hun-  
 dred and ten dollars to them paid by John Nations of the district & State  
 aforesaid Have granted bargained and Released and by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said John Nations one hundred  
 and ninety one acres of Land more or less being a tract of Land originally  
 granted to James Harrison & signed by his excellency Thomas Pinckney on the 2<sup>d</sup>  
 day of June 1783. The said one hundred & ninety one acres of Land more or less  
 is laid out unto the said John Nations as follows, Beginning on a gum station  
 near a branch running thence N.W. 20° to Gilliam corner a post oak thence N.E. 70° six  
 Chains & a half to a post oak corner from thence N.W. 30° a direct straight course  
 to Hudsons Stake corner from thence near a large bank on the north side said  
 branch from thence North Eastward along Curals line with course to rocky river  
 from thence down the said river meanders so far as will intersect with a certain  
 line originally made for William Rogain thence N.W. 88° to the corner, thence  
 S.W. 24° a large branch from thence up the said branch with the meander to  
 the beginning, including one hundred and ninety one acres of Land more or less  
 Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments appurtenances  
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and  
 To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John  
 Nations his heirs and assigns forever. I do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs  
 Exel<sup>ts</sup> & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
 one hundred <sup>4 ninety one</sup> acres of Land more or less, with the premises unto the said John  
 Nations his heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs & assigns & all & every  
 other person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof we do hereunto set our hands  
 and seals this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 1805
