

This Indenture made the twenty second day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and nine between Henry Chambers of Greenville District and State of South Carolina of the one part and Aaron Kempf of the aforesaid State and district of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Chambers for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Aaron Kempf the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the Henry Chambers hath and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Aaron Kempf a certain tract or piece of Land lying & being in Greenville District on Branchy of Enoree River containing Two hundred acres be the same more or less it being part of a tract of Land originally granted to Wreak Bonner, Beginning on a poplar on a branch whereon the old meeting house formerly stood and running N. 25. 5 to a hickory thence N. 19. E. 15. 50 to a hickory thence N. 5 W. 9 to a red oak thence W. 20. 5 to a stake thence S. 13 to a red oak thence N. 35 to a pine thence S. to a post oak corner, thence a marked conditional line to the head of the meeting house branch thence down the south side of said branch to the Beginning, which said tract of two ^{more or less} be the same more or less with all and every with all and every of its appurtenances the said Henry Chambers doth from himself and his heirs and from all and every other Person or Persons will warrant and forever defend to the said Aaron Kempf his heirs and assigns forever, In Witness whereof the said Henry Chambers hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written - Signed sealed and Delivered in presence of Rob^t Macafee
