The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I John Blasingame of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars to me paid by Joseph Alston of the State aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and Relented unto by these presents Do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Joseph Alston all that plantation piece or parcel of Land containing two hundred acres and laid out and designated as follows, To wit Beginning at a Red oak corner and running S. 78 E. 45 to a Stake corner thence S. 35 W. 18 to a P. O. corner thence S. 55 E. 18 to a R. O. corner, thence S. 25 E. 22 to a Stake corner thence N. 83 W. 47 to a R. O. thence N. 31 W. 28 to a Pine, thence N. 6 E. 25.50. to the Beginning corner, Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Plantation piece or parcel of Land above described, Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Alston his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said plantation piece or parcel of land above described unto the said Joseph Alston his heirs or assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this ninth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten, and in the thirty fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America, Executed and Delivered in the presence of
