 with interest thereon as aforesaid according to the true intent and meaning of the said  
 bond or obligation and these presents that then and in such case it shall & may be  
 Lawfull to and for the said Beverly Borrowum his certain attorney his heirs Executors  
 administrators or assigns or agents from time to time and at all times hereafter peaceably  
 and quietly to enter into any or all the Lands messuages or Tenements of the said William  
 Bray and to take the said property into his or their possession and the same to hold and  
 detain to his own proper use & behoof as his own proper goods & chattels, from thence  
 forth and forever, or the same to sell and dispose of at his will and pleasure returning  
 the surplus if any should happen to be after paying the said sum of thirty four  
 dollars 75 cts with the interest as aforesaid together with costs & charges attending  
 the same, to the said William his certain attorney his heirs executors administrators  
 or assigns In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth  
 day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten & 31<sup>st</sup>  
 year of American Independence, signed sealed and Delivered in the Presence

 Senior of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of  
 one thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas Harrison, (my son) Have granted  
 bargained sold and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release  
 unto the said Thomas Harrison his heirs and assigns forever, all that part of a certain  
 tract of Land lying and being in the District and State aforesaid, on the waters of Red  
 River originally granted unto Henry Tomeny (alias Domine) for 200 acres the part  
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
