 South Carolina, Know all men by these presents, that I Jordan Holcombe  
 of the State of South Carolina & District of Greenville in consideration of the sum  
 of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Thomas Howard of the State, and  
 District aforesaid, I grant bargained & sold & released unto the said Thomas Howard  
 a plantation or tract of Land lying & being in Greenville District, State aforesaid  
 Beginning on a Locust an agreed corner, between Hinchon Holcombe & Henry Bates  
 thence to a marked beach on the creek called Barton's fork of Tyger River thence on to  
 a stake corner, thence along the original line to a stake thence across the creek to  
 a spanish oak on the top of a hill, thence on to a stake on the original line, thence  
 along the old line of Lynch to or against the Beginning Locust, supposed fifty acres  
 of land to be the same more or less, the same being part of a tract of Land granted to  
 William Davis and by William Davis conveyed to John Davidson, then John Davidson  
 conveyed the aforesaid part to Hinchon Holcombe and by Hinchon Holcomb  
 conveyed to Jordan Holcombe & by Jordan Holcombe conveyed to said Thomas Howard
