-land of the aforesaid State and district the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have
granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents Do grant bargain sell
and Release unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland one certain house and lot or parcel
of land, supposed to contain one half acre, situate and lying being in Pleasantburg
in the district and State aforesaid, being the south half of two lots known and disting-
-ued by chart of said village by N^o 34 & 35, and laid out as follows Beginning at a stake
N^o 74¹/₂ W. 235 feet to a stake, N^o 15¹/₂ E. 70 feet to a stake, S^o 74¹/₂ E. 235 feet to a
stake, thence S^o 15¹/₂ W. 70 feet to the Beginning, which lot or parcel of Land
was conveyed by William Anderson, Sheriff of Greenville district and State aforesaid
to William Joney on the fifth day of August one thousand eight hundred & six-
