appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To Have & To hold all and singular the premises, before
mentioned unto the said George M Owen his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators, to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said one hundred and
ten acres of Land more or less with the premises unto the said George M
Owen his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs, assigns and all
and every other person or persons whatsoever, I do Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this ninth day of November one
thousand Eight hundred and one, signed sealed and Delivered
in presence of Mr. Pollard

This Indenture made this seventh of February in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred between Henry Linderman of Greenville
County and State of South Carolina of the one part & Thomas Cape of the
County State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry Linderman
for and in consideration of the sum of forty five pounds Sterling money to
him in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt is truly acknowledged and hath granted
bargained and sold released & confirmed, and by these presents bargain
