State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that William Dailey of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of sixty nine pounds nineteen shillings Sterling money to me paid by Lion Turner of the district of Greenville State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto Lion Turner a certain piece or parcel of Land lying in Greenville district and State aforesaid, containing two hundred acres more or less bounded Northwardly on lands laid out for James Blasingame South East on lands laid out for Robert Gilliland West on Saluda River being part of a tract of Land of nine hundred acres originally granted to James Nicholson - Beginning on a small pine, thence running with John Bowles Line 21: 50 Ch: to a lightwood Stake corner, thence 170 Chains to a Hickory corner on the river, thence down the River 26 Ch: to a black oak corner
