thence East 36 Ch. to a red oak 3⁺ thence S. W. 21. 125 Ch. to a black oak 3⁺
on the original line, thence to a post oak 3⁺ 2 Ch. course not remembered
thence S. 20 W. 15 to a stone 3⁺ thence S. 70 W. 22 Ch. to a post oak 3⁺ on a road
and Pedery line thence S. 40 E. 23 Ch. to a hickory 3⁺ cut down, thence S. 48.
W. 20 Ch. to a hickory on Needy River thence down said River by its meanders
to the Beginning, Containing four hundred acres & the same more or less -
I do Have and do Hold all and singular the premises as above described
unto the said George Terry his heirs and assigns for ever, Together with all
and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, And
do hereby bind myself & my heirs, executors or administrators to warrant & forever
defend the premises aforesaid unto the said George Terry his heirs and assigns
against myself and my heirs or assigns, & against every person or persons
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In Witness
