

State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Josiah Culbertson of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, in Consideration of Three hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by George Salmon of the State and district aforesaid, Have granted bargain sold and Released, and by these presents Do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said George Salmon all that tract of Land containing two hundred acres, Beginning at a black oak on the South side of South Tigger River, running up the various meanders thereof to the mouth of the Rocky Branch thence up the meanders of said branch to a sweet gum corner, over the branch from the said sweet gum East sixty five Chain to a stake thence N. 20 E. 30 Ch. to Jesse Rectors corner (remains of a pine) N. 55 E. 12 Ch. to stake Henry Cannons & thence N. 35 E. 15 Ch. to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members & hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining

To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Salmon his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and favour defend all singular the said Premises (agreeable to a plat herewith annexed) unto the said George Salmon his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & assigns every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand & seal this 25th day of August in the year of our Lord 1810 - Jos.
