South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I Little B. Roach  
of Pendleton dist. and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of  
three hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph Roach of Greenville  
district and State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released &  
by these presents Do grant bargain and sell unto the S. Joseph Roach a  
plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the State & district  
aforesaid, on Maple Creek waters of Reedy River, it being a part of two  
tracts one originally granted to Charles Pope the other granted to Croft, and  
conveyed through different hands down to the S. L. B. Roach, the land to be  
conveyed. Begins on a P. O. 34 S 13 W. 15.50 to hickory 34 S 40 E. 65 by Butler line com-  
ing to Pine 34 then to B. Jack N. 50 E. 15.50 to stake then N 40 W. to condition at  
comer bounded by Samuel Dyer, then with the S. Conditional line to Pine 34 on the  
original line, then N. 40 W. to B. Jack 34 S 50 W. 45 to Beginning P. O. including two  
hundred and sixteen acres. Together with all and singular the rights, member-  
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident  
or appertaining, To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto the  
said Joseph Roach and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said Joseph Roach his heirs and assigns forever against myself and my heirs  
and against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the  
5<sup>th</sup> January in the year of our Lord 1809. Signed and Delivered in presence of  
Jest. B. Griffith, John <sup>his</sup> Kelley mark Little B. X. Roach <sup>his</sup> mark

South Carolina Greenville District, Appear personally before me John Kelley & make  
oath in due form of Law & saith that he was present and saw Little B. Roach sign  
and deliver the within deed of Conveyance to Joseph Roach for the use & purpose  
therew mentioned and also saw Benj. Griffith sign the same as concuring witness  
with himself Sworn & Subscribed before me this 5<sup>th</sup> January 1809.
