South Carolina Greenville District; Personally came Stephen Easley before me the subscribing Justice and being duly sworn maketh oath that he saw Thomas Easley sign seal and deliver the within deed to Samuel Townes for the uses & purposes therein mentioned, and that Blackman Ligon and Samuel Saxton, were subscribing witnesses with himself to the said Sworn to & subscribed before me this 4th day of July 1811 Stephen Easley

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Johnathan Ward of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Silas Hollaway of the State and District aforesaid, I have granted bargained sold & Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Silas Hollaway one certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred acres more or less, situate in the District of Greenville on the waters of the Golden Grove Creek being part of a tract of Land originally granted to William Armstrong by grant bearing date the fifteenth of October 1784 and by him conveyed to the said Johnathan Ward by deed bearing date the Eighth day of June 1795. and Recorded in the Clerks office in book D. page 144. the 11th day of August 1795. Beginning on a Red oak corner on Judge Pendletons line near the branch thence by a line of marked trees agreed on by the parties to the mouth of Henry Paris's spring branch thence up the meanders of the main branch to William Brashers line thence N. 45 E. 40 chains along William Brashers line to a corner agreed on by the parties, thence S. 45 E. 40 chains with a line of marked trees to the head of the Indigo dam branch thence down the meander of the said branch to an ash corner on the original line, thence S. 45 W. with the said line to the Beginning, Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises to the said Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Silas Hollaway his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Silas Hollaway his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other Persons or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
