State of Carolina Greenville District; Know all men by these presents that we Thomas & Aquilla Brasher of State and District aforesaid, Have sold and by these presents doth sell and release unto Joseph Jackson of the State and District aforesaid for the sum of Two hundred Dollars paid by said Jackson, all that tract of land containing one hundred and fifty two acres more or less laid out to s^r Joseph Jackson as follows, Beginning on a white oak thence running N. 34 N. 36 Ch. to a pine c. thence N. 5 Ch. to a Post oak c. thence S. 21 E. 24 c. to a sowerwood on the bank of the Rudy fork, thence down said Creek in the middle of the same to a water oak thence N. 58 E. 37 ch to the Beginning, Including one hundred and fifty two acres more or less— Together with all that appertains to the s^r tract of land above described and premises, we the above Thomas & Aquilla Brasher doth warrant and forever defend the same to Joseph Jackson his heirs and assigns forever, against ourselves our heirs & assigns & from & against all other Person claiming the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof we the said Thomas & Aquilla Brasher do hereunto set our hands this Eleventh day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred Seven, Witnessed in presence of us
