and the said Rhoda Evans doth for himself and his heirs forever, warrant
and defend an indefeasible right and title in the said negroes unto the
said William H. Davis against me my heirs and assigns, In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of March 1812
